Wednesday Jan 6th 11.49

Begins with good breeze from E.S.E. with cloudy weather Ship off and on at Howe's Island At 7 P.M. got the draft of Water on board and stowed it also some recruits. At 7 P.M. stood off from the Land under short sail Henry Saunders still lying in a dangerous state, can not speak, but appears to know what is said to him and answers by signs, Middle nearly Calm Latter part light breeze from E.S.E. Working up to the Land, under all sail

Thursday Jan 7th 11.50

Begins with light breeze from E.N.E. with fine weather At 2 P.M. got up to the Land and sent two Boats on Shore, At 5 P.M. the Boats returned to the Ship, and the Capt came on board At 8 P.M. kept off steering S by W. To Night Henry Saunders much better and Eats & Drinks & Speaks some Middle part Wind the same Latter part good breeze from East steering South

Lat 31:52 Long 159 00

Friday Jan 8th 11.51

Begins with moderate breeze from East with good weather Ship under all sail steering South At dusk shortened sail & luffed to the Wind on the Eastern tack Henry Saunders still better. Middle & Latter parts light breeze from N.N.W. with fair weather

Saturday Jan 9th 11.52

Begins with light breeze from N.W. with light showers of Rain Ship under all sail steering to the S.W. Henry Saunders still better. Middle part Wind hauled to E.S.E. with light breeze and Rainy weather Latter part the same steering South No Ob

Sunday Jan 10th 11.53

Begins with light airs from E.S.E. with cloudy weather and some Rain Ship under all sail steering by to the South Middle & Latter parts light breeze from N.E. with good weather Henry Saunders much better, sent him forward Lat 34:32

Monday Jan 11th 11.54

Begins with light breeze from N.E. with good weather Ship under all sail steering South by E. Middle part the Wind hauled to North with strong winds & Rainy weather Latter part shifted to S.W. and weather clear. Made same sail heading to the Westward

Tuesday Jan 12th 11.55

Begins with strong winds from S.W. with clear weather Ship under Reefed Topsails heading to the Westward Middle & Latter parts light airs from South with good weather Lat 34:14 Long 158:43

Wednesday Jan 13th 11.56

Begins nearly Calm with fine weather Middle & Latter parts good breeze from N.N.W. with good weather Ship under all sail Cruising. Released Joseph Lopez from Prison & sent him on Duty

Thursday Jan 14th 11.57

Begins with strong breeze from N.W. with clear weather Ship under all sail Cruising At 3.30 P.M. saw Two Sperm Whales going quick to Windward Lowered three Boats in Chase, but could not come up to them Middle part Wind died out to Calm with Thunder Lightning & Torrents of Rain Latter part light breeze from S.E. with good weather Lat 33:35 Long 157:40
