Wednesday Jan 27th 1170
Begins with good breeze from West. with
signs of a blow Employed Boiling
Middle part. Wind hauled in a Squall
with pouring Rain to South and blew on
to Moderate Gale Latter part Wind the
same with heavy Sea. Cut up the other
junk and put it in Casks

Thursday Jan 28th 1171
Begins with Moderate from South with
heavy sea running Employed Boiling
Middle part Wind Moderated to Strong
breeze with heavy swell, Latter part the same
Lat 35:00 Long 158:40

Friday Jan 29th 1172
Begins with Moderate Wind from South
with heavy swell Emp Boiling Middle
part. Wind hauled to N.W. with cloudy
weather Latter part the same
Lat 34:40 Long 158:50

Saturday Jan 30th 1173
Begins with Moderate breeze from N.W.
with cloudy weather Ship Under all
sail Cruising at dark finished
Boiling Filled the Tank with Oil and
& stowed some between Decks
Put John Galagar Boy in Irons for being
Saucy & refusing to Obey Orders
Middle & Latter part, Wind & weather
the same Employed Stowing Oil

Begins with strong Northerly winds. with cloudy
weather Ship under Topsails & Fore Course
Cruising. Middle part Wind hauled to South
Latter part the same with strong Wind and
thick weather Employed Stowing Oil in after
Hold. No Obs

Tuesday Feb 2nd 1176
Begins with strong Wind from South
with thick weather stowing down Oil.
Middle & Latter parts Wind & weather same
Finished Stowing. The Two Whales Making 150
barrels. Lat 34:39 Long 158:09

Wednesday Feb 3rd 1177
Begins with strong breeze from S.E. with
cloudy weather Ship Under Topsails & Courses
Cruising. Middle & Latter parts Moderate
winds from N.E. with good weather

Thursday Feb 4th 1178
Begins with Moderate breeze from N.E. with
good weather Ship Under all sail Cruising
Middle & Latter the same Lat 34:50 Long 158:00

Friday Feb 5th 1179
Begins with Wind & weather the same
with thick weather Ship Under short sail
Cruising. Middle & Latter parts strong
winds from same quarter Ship Under
Reefered Topsails No Obs
