2.53 Barrels of Spum & 5.19 Barrels of Harp buck
At 3 P.M. took the Steamer and was towed to the
New Wharf to discharge more oil

Friday 19th
This day Commenced with clear weather, all Hands Employed
in landing the oil on the wharf and other duty
Ship being as fast as usual So Ends this day

Saturday 20th
This day begins with fine weather the Men Employed
on backing out oil and other duty So Ends this day

Sunday 21st
fine weather all through the day all hands on Shore
So Ends

Monday 21st
This day begins with fine weather, Men Employed
in discharging oil and other duty So Ends this day

Tuesday 22nd
Fine Clear Weather the men Employed in backing out
the oil and other duty So Ends this day

Wednesday 23rd
Clear Weather all through the day with a Clear Sky
at 10 am the Steamer Come along side and took the
Ship ~~the ship~~ at 2 p.m. the Ship was hauled on
the ways.
all hands Employed in Ships duty So Ends

Commenced stripping the bottom of the Ship,
The Crew Employed in picking up old Coopers and nails
and other duty So Ends this day

Friday 25th
This day begins with a pleasant day.
The Carpenter is not at work on a Count of a Howle day
the Men Employed in Ships duty picking up old nails
and Coopers and So Ends this day.

Saturday 26th
Fine Clear Weather all through the day with a light
breeze. all the men Employed in picking up the Coopers
and Nails that is taken off the Bottom of the Ship
and other duty So Ends this day.

Sunday 27th
pleasant weather all through the day men on liberty
So Ends this day.

Monday 28th
This day Commenced with Clear weather.
The men Employed in Ships duty
Satter part Carpenters off on a Howday
the crew on different duty So Ends this day

Tuesday 29th
light breeze all through these 24 hours.
all hands Employed in taking care of
the old Coopers and Nails and other duty

Wednesday March 30th
This day begins with a light breeze
Carpenters Employed in working on the
Ship found the Seams and bits in a
bad state. also the Trunnels broke off between
the plank and timbers. other ways the Bottom
was in good order.
