

Bark Mary Frasier of New Bedford April 15th 1845

Thursday 15th

First of this Clear Weather after noon Strong
Breeze and rain at times.
Captains Employed Copring the Ship and
duty.
The Crew Employed in painting Ship and other duty
So Ends this day.

Friday 16th

This day Begins with Clear weather
Not through Copring yet. Blung the Rudder and
finished up some other work and commenced
fitting the New Pumps. So Ends this day.

Saturday 17th

To day pleasant weather got through Copring
Landing down the Stages and fitting the Miller
and other work.

Sunday 18th

This day fine Clear weather all Hands on liberty
So Ends this day.

Monday 19th

To day Clear Weather, at 10 a.m. Ship Came out of
Ship Stumer Coued the Ship Close the Wharf
got her made fast at Sunset So Ends this day.

Tuesday 20th

This day Begins with Rain not much
going on once out of rain So Ends this day.

Wednesday 21st

dark heavy looking weather with some Rain
The Crew Employed in Storing back the Cargo
and other duty So Ends this day.

at Hobart Town April 22nd 1846

Thursday 22nd

Clear Weather all through the day with a few drops from
The Crew Employed Storing water and breaking out the oil
that was left in the after hole and setting up
Shooks and other duty So Ends this day.

Friday 23rd

This day Fine Clear weather at work Storing oil
Setting up Shooks. Sent the old Coopers off and Sales
and Copring oil. So Ends this day.

Saturday 24th

Fine Clear Weather all through the day
The Crew Employed in Storing down oil and other
work Copring oil setting up Shooks So Ends this day.

Sunday 25th

To day Fine Clear weather all through the day
all Hands on liberty So Ends this day.

Monday 26th

This day Clear Weather, all hands Employed
in Storing oil and water.
Received on board 6000 pounds of bread
So Ends this day.

Tuesday 27th

This day dark heavy weather Employed in Storing
pipes for water down 100 bbls of water setting up
Shooks and duty,
two Lebars at work So Ends this day.

Wednesday 28th

Dark Heavy weather with some Rain. the men Employed
in filling some of the ground teas with salt water
Received 15 Measures of Beef and 4000 pounds of Flour.
The Coopers Employed in setting up Shooks So Ends
