Sunday May 25th
This day begins with a gale from WNW
Ship under close reefed topsails and fore sail
steering N. middle part the same later part
wind S at three P.M. took in the fore
topsail so ends the day

Monday May 26th
This day begins and ends with a strong breeze
from WNW ship under double reefed
topsails and fore sail steering N by E
so ends the day

Lat 38-30 S
Tuesday May 27th
This day begins and ends with a fresh gale
from the SW ship under close reefed topsails
and fore sail steering N by W so ends
the day in

Lat 35-50 S
Wednesday May 28th
This day begins and ends with fine weather
wind from SE ship under all sail
steering N by W the watch employed
making ship so ends the day in

Lat 35-00
Thursday May 29th
This day begins and ends with a strong
breeze from ENE ship under all
sail steering N by W one sail in
sight working to the eastward
so ends the day

Friday May 30th
This day begins with a strong breeze from
ENE ship under topsails and fore sail
jib and mainsail steering N by W at
ten double reefed. Middle and later
part wind from N weather clear at
dark more ship hearing ENE so
ends the day

Saturday May 29th
This day begins and ends with a fresh breeze
from WNW ship under double reefed topsails
and courses steering N the watch employed at
old jobs so ends the day

Sunday May 30th
This day begins and ends with light fine
weather wind from SW ship under double
reefed topsails and courses steering different
courses so ends the day

Monday May 31st
This day begins with a light breeze and
fine weather wind from SE ship and
different tacks gamen with the
Matilda Sears sent down the fore
topsail and munched it so ends the
day

Tuesday June 1st
This twenty four hours began and ends
with fine weather wind from SE
ship on the port tack under all
sail gamen the Matilda Sears at
dark took in sail so ends the day

Wednesday June 2nd
This day begins and ends with a strong breeze
from ESE ship on both tacks the watch
employed at old jobs Breakout shakes
and hoists cooper Bery sitting up east

Thursday June 3rd
This day began and ends with a fine
breeze from E ship under all sail on
the S tarboard tack the watch employed
trimming ship so at dark took in the
light sails so ends the day
