Tuesday July 6th
This Day began with a strong breeze from S.W. ship under all sail steering E. S. E. Middle and later parts the same so ends the Day

Wednesday July 7th
This Day began with a fresh breeze from S. E. ship under all sail by the wind on the S. S. Middle and later parts the same

Thursday July 8th
This twenty four hours began with a strong breeze from S. E. ship under topsails by the wind on the S. S. Middle part the same later part wind from E. S. E. so ends the Day

Friday July 9th
This Day began with a strong breeze from E. S. E. ship under topsails and courses by the wind on the S. S. Middle and later parts the same

Saturday 10th
This Day begins and ends with a strong breeze from E. S. E. ship under double reefed topsails and courses for part on the S. S. Middle and later on the S. S.

Sunday July 11th
This Day strong winds all through from E. S. E. ship by the wind on the S. S. under reefed topsails and courses so ends the Day

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Monday July 12th
This twenty four hours began with a fresh breeze from S. S. E. ship under all sail steering E. by N. Middle and later parts the same

Tuesday July 13th
This Day began and ends with a strong breeze from S. S. E. ship under all sail steering E. Middle and later parts the same so ends the Day

Wednesday 14th
This Day began with a strong breeze from S. S. E. ship under topsails steering E. Middle and later parts wind baffled ship under all sail steering E. S. E.

Thursday July 15th
This Day began with a fresh breeze from S. S. E. ship under all sail steering E. by N. Middle and later parts wind light from the same quarter

Friday July 16th
This Day began with a strong breeze from S. S. E. ship under reefed topsails and courses by the wind on the S. S. Middle and later parts the weather the same ship on different tacks

Saturday July 17th
This twenty four hours a fresh gail all through from S. S. E. to E. S. E. ship under reefed topsails and courses remain so ends the twenty four hours
