Sunday July 18th
This day began with a fresh gail
from E ship under reefed topsails and

Monday July 19th
This twenty four hours began with

reefed topsails and corres crew in
Mistle and later parts the same

Tuesday July 20th
This day began with a fresh breeze
from E & S ship under reefed
topsails and corres crew in
Mistle and later parts moderate
weather with light rain squalls
wind baffin

Wednesday July 21st
This day began with a strong
breeze from E & S ship & by
the wind on board lacks Mistle
and later part wind light later
part wind from S & E ship
under all sail steering E

Thursday July 22nd
This day began with a fresh
breeze from N & W ship under
all sail by the wind on the
P & Mistle part the same
Leaky part wind from S ship
under all sail steering
N by E weather thick and
raining so even the day

At Tonga-hape

Friday July 23rd
This day began with a strong breeze
from S & W ship under all sail steering
N Mistle and later parts Baffin
squally weather

Saturday 24th
This day began with light squally
weather sent down the fore topsail and
jib and mizen then Mistle and
later parts strong breeze from
S & E ship under all sail steering
N so ends the day

Sunday July 25th
This day began and ends with fine
weather wind from E & S ship under
all sail steering N & W at four P.M.
saw the Island of Tonga-hape
Baring W distance fifteen miles of at
dark wore ship on the of shore tack
under double reefed topsails so ends
the twelve hours

Monday July 26th
This twelve hours began and ends
with a strong breeze from E & S
At six A.M. saw the land kept of
under topsails and corres At nine
A.M. came to anchor in fifteen
fathoms with seventy five fathoms
shackled on the windlass sent
down the fore top galum yard
rove the cutting gear and so
forth

Tuesday July 27th
This day strong breeze till through
all hands getting ready to whail it
saw two or three whales
