A.M. calmer all hands are got
ready to get under way sent
sails and sent up yards at
Day light took the anchor and
went to sea At Dark the Island
of Mooker Baring E Distance
ten Miles ship under full
sail steering S

Friday Sep. the 18th
This Day began and ended with
light N wind at Day light raised
the Island of Tonga Baring
S at twelve A.M. came to anchor
in the Bay in twelve fathoms

Saturday Sep. the 19th
This Day began with a calm
Coast four Boats W.B.
struck and got a Whale
got him a long side at four
P.M. and commenced to cut

Sunday Sept. the 20th
This twelve hours began and ended
with thick rainy weather mine
from S E at six A.M. started to
cut got him in and started
the Works

Monday Sep. the 21st
This Day fine weather All through
All four Boats Town saw but few
Whals

Tuesday Sep. the 22nd
Fine Weather all of the Boats of
saw a few Whals very shy

Wednesday Sep. the 23rd
This Day began with a strong
Breeze from W.S.W. Coast all four
Boats B.B. struck a Whale near
"of short time" saw up sent the
B.B. to the ship stove hooked
on three Boats and tried to
get in at ten or eleven got B.B.
in 20 fathoms let go the anchor
at 10 past two P.M. the anchor rope
parted let go of the Whale and started
for an Island it blowing here and
very rough All Day light landed

Thursday Sep. the 24th
Strong Wind from S.W. the Boats
All Day getting on board

Friday the 25th
This Day light fine Weather Wind
S E all four Boats of went to
see if the Whale could be
found on the reef but could
not find him saw a number
of Whals
