Friday Nov the 26th

This Day begins with a gail from N.W ship under a close reefed Main topsail on the S.S. at three A.M. wind shifted in to S.W at Tark blowing hard from S.W so ends the day or fore part Middle and later parts the same

Lat 34° 40' S Long 152° 40' E

Saturday Nov the 27th

This Day begins with a gail from S.W ship under a close reefed Main topsail on the S.S. so in the fore part Middle the same later part weather side of the Main topsail filled so ends the day

Lat 34° 05' S

Sunday Nov the 28th

This Day begins with a gail from S.S.W ship under a close reefed Main topsail on the S.S. at five A.M. more ship heaving S.E. on the S.S. Middle part the same later part ship under double reefed topsails and covers weather fine

Lat 35° 36' S Long 152° 14'

Monday Nov 29th

This Day begins with fine weather wind S.S.W ship under all sail on the S.S. heaving W by S so ends the fore part Middle the same later part light wind from N.E ship under all sail steering S.W by S so ends the day

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Tuesday Nov the 30th

This Day begins with light fair weather wind from N.E ship under all sail steering S.W by S at sundown Middle and later parts the same

Lat 35° 29' S Long 152° 45'

Wednesday Dec the 1st

This Day begins with a strong breeze from N ship under all sail steering S.W at Tark took in sail came to on the S.S. heaving W.N.W Middle part weather the same later part ship under double reefed topsails and stays steering S.W

Lat 35° 50' S

Thursday Dec the 2nd

This Day begins with a fresh gail from N ship under double reefed topsails and stays steering S.W at sundown came to the wind on the S.S. heaving E.N.E ship under the lee clew of the Main topsail so ends the fore part Middle part wind from S heaving heavy later part wind W.S.W ship on the S.S. under double reefed topsails and fore sail so ends the day

Lat 36° 10' S Long 152° 00'

Friday Dec the 3rd

This Day begins with a strong breeze from W.S.W ship under reefed topsails and fore sail on the S.S. at Tark a close reefed the topsails so ends the fore part Middle the same later part wind W.N.W ship under all sail on the S.S. so ends the day
