Wednesday Jan the 5th

This Day begins with light fine weather wind from E ship under all sail crews in at seven down took in sail Middle part weather the same later part strong breeze from N.N.E

Thursday Jan the 6th

This Day begins with a strong breeze from N.N.E ship under topsails and courses crews in at Dark lost reefed Main topsail Middle and later parts calm squally weather ship under topsails crews in so ends the Day

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Friday Jan the 7th

This Day begins with light calm squally weather ship under topsails crews in at Dark lost reefed the Main topsail so ends the fore part Middle part raining very hard with much thunder and lightning later part light fine weather ship under all sail crews in

Saturday Jan the 8th

This Day begins with light fine weather ship under all sail crews in at Dark shortened sail so ends the fore part Middle part the same later ship under topsails on the wind hearing E.N.E. sail in sight

Sunday Jan the 9th

This Day begins with fine weather ship under topsails and courses on the S.S. wind N.W. at Dark took in the courses so ends the fore part Middle part the same later part a fresh gale from N ship under reefed topsails on the S.S. so ends the Day in

Monday Jan the 10th Lat 36.15 S Long 158.20 E This Day begins with a fresh gale from N.N.W ship under double reefed topsails on the S.S. at Dark wore ship took in sail to De lost reefed Main topsail so ends the fore part Middle part calm wind S.W. later part fine breeze from S.W. ship under all sail steering N.W.

Tuesday Jan the 11th

This Day begins with a moderate breeze from S.W. ship under all sail by the wind on the S.S. at Dark shortened sail Middle part the same later part wind S.E. ship under topsails steering N.N.W. so ends the Day in
