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Friday Feb the 4th
This Day begins with a strong breeze from E.S.E. ship under topsails and courses on the S.S. so ends the first part Middle part the same later ship on the point tack so ends the Day with wind and weather the same in

This Day begins with a strong wind from E.S.E. ship under topsails and courses on the S.S. heaving S so ends the fore part Middle the same later part ship on the S.S. heaving N.E. so ends the Day
