N & E at sun. B.M. Backed in to S & E at
dark put the ship under a close reefed
Main topsail on the S.S. heading N & E
so ends the fore part of the Day Middle

reefed topsails and fore sail blowing
heavy from S & E at eleven S.M. took in
fore sail and fore topsail so ends the Day

S & E ship on the S.S. under a close reefed
Main topsail at dark finer the weather
clew of the Main topsail Middle
