N. ship on the S.S. under reefed topsails and
courses at Dark stowed the courses so ends the
fore part at eleven A.M. took in the Main
topsail later part weather thick and rainy
wind N.N.W. ship on the S.S. under all close
reefed Main topsail and storm sails so ends the Day

Saturday Mar the 4th
This Day begins with a gail and thick rainy
weather from N.N.W. ship under storm
sails on the S.S. so ends the fore part
Middle part the same later part wind S.E.
ship under all sail on the S.S. two Barks
in sight so ends the Day in
