Thursday Mar the 16th
This day begins with a fresh gail from
E ship on the S.S. under double reefed
topsails and fore sail so ends the fore
part with two sails in sight
Middle part the same later part wind light
from S.E. ship under all sail on the S.S.

Friday Mar the 17th
This day begins with light fine weather
wind S.E. ship under all sail on the
S.S. at dark gale with the spatula. Sails
so ends the fore part Middle and later
part ship under all sail steering W.S.W.
wind S.E. very light so ends the day in
Lat 35.06 S

Saturday Mar the 18th Lon 178.50 E
This day begins with a strong breeze
from S ship on the S.S. by the wind and
sail in sight washed ship so ends the fore
part Middle part strong breeze ship on both
tacks later fresh gail from S.W. ship under
double reefed topsails and courses so ends the day
Lat 35.46 S

Sunday Mar the 19th Lon 179.20 E
This day begins with a fresh gail from
S.W. ship on the S.S. under double reefed
topsails and courses so ends the fore part Middle
part the same later part ship under main
topgallant sail and flying jib so ends
Lat 35.18 S
Lon 179.36 E

Monday Mar the 20th
This day begins with a strong breeze
from W ship under all sail on the S.S.
At dark stowed the light sails and
were ship heading N.N.W. Middle part
the same later part ship on the S.S. heading
S.W. by S. so ends the day in
Lat 35.40 S
Lon 179.12

Tuesday Mar the 21st
This day begins with a strong breeze from W. ship
under topsails and courses by the wind and different
tacks at dark on the S.S. heading N.N.W. Middle
part the same later part ship on the S.S. under
all sail so ends the day in
Lat 35.20 S
Lon 176.45 E

Wednesday Mar the 22nd
This day begins with fine weather wind backing
from S.W. to N.N.W. ship under all sail and different
tacks beating so ends the fore part Middle part
the same later part a gail from N.N.W. ship
under double reefed topsails and fore sail

Thursday Mar the 23rd
This day begins with a fresh gail from N.N.W.
ship under double reefed main topsail and
foresail on the S.S. at dark wind N.W. weather
equally stowed the fore sail and close reefed
the main topsail so ends the fore part
Middle part weather the the same ship
under a few clew of the main topsail later
part wind S.W. with heavy squalls ship on
different tacks so ends the day in
Lat 36.20

Friday ~~Thursday~~ Mar the 24th Lon 178.47
This day begins with a fresh gail from
S.W. ship under close reefed topsails
part of the time courses weather equally
at dark on the S.S. heading S.S.E. so ends
the fore part At ten A.M. W. ship weather
the same later part light fine weather wind
S.S.W. ship under all sail by the wind on
the S.S. so ends the day in
Lat 36.10 S
Lon 176.46 E
