

Thursday - July - 29 - 1858
at daylight this morning tacked ship in shore
The Captain went on shore, the ship lying off
and on; at noon the Captain came on board
with a Pilot; when we run in and dropped anchor.
furled sails and cleared up decks.

Friday July 30 - 1858
sent in a boat crew to cut Wood
in the afternoon filled and got on board
9 bask of Water; Washed the out-side of the ship
and painted the chains

Saturday July 31 - 1858
a part of the crew went ashore to cut Wood
brought on board two boatloads of Wood
and a small raft of Water

Sunday August 1 - 1858
lying at anchor: all hands on liberty

Monday August 2 - 1858

Got on board four boatloads of Wood
and a raft of Water

heading N.W. my my my
Tuesday August 3 - 1858
Stowed down Wood and Water my
the Foreman and his lady came on board today

my my my my my
Wednesday August 4 - 1858
This morning weighed anchor and stood to sea
lowered for humpbacks did not fasten
6 sails in sight

Thursday August 5 - 1858
heading N.W. caught a turtle and saw
White - water

my my my my
Friday August 6 - 1858
heading S.E. one sail in sight

Saturday August 7 - 1858
raining, heading S.E. saw land and a sail. Washed ship
