Saturday August th -21- 1858
on the Starboard tack heading East
Strong winds with rain
Washed Ship

Sunday August th -22- 1858
on the Starboard tack heading E. S.E.
Cloudy With Strong Winds

Monday August th -23- 1858
on the Starboard tack heading E. S.E.
Strong Wind with rain: at night Wore
Ship heading West

Tuesday August th -24- 1858
on the Starboard tack heading S. E. by E
Saw Porpoises a finback and Blackfish
