

Saturday September 4 - 1858
Saw humpbacks above Sherk and two sails
head wind

Sunday September 5 - 1858
Payta headlands in sight - Saw humpbacks and
Blackfish and three sails

Monday September 6 - 1858
at daylight ~~the~~ stood in for land
raised Payta head at eight in the morning
humpbacks Blackfish and four sails in sight
got up to Payta at night blew down topsails
and set go the anchor

Tuesday September 7 - 1858
at daylight hove up the anchor and towed
the ship in about a mile and dropped anchor
the starboard watch went ashore on liberty
a whaleship merchantman and man-of-war steamship
came in to day

Wednesday September 8 - 1858
Started two cask of water. The starboard watch
went ashore on liberty

Thursday September 9 - 1858
The starboard watch went on liberty
Painted ship and started ten barrels meat
into casks hooked the barrels for oil

Friday September 10 - 1858
bought 25 bls from the Schlonka and
filled them with whale oil. Painted ship
on the starboard side. The starboard watch on liberty

Saturday September 11 - 1858
Setting up the head rigging and sent on shore
30 bl. oil washed ship. The ~~starboard~~ starboard
watch went on liberty

Sunday Sep. 12 - 1858
The starboard watch went ashore on liberty
