

Monday Sep th 13 - 1858
all hands aboard and ready for sea
at night mended the windlass hove up
our anchor made sail and stood to sea
in company with the spruce New Bedford

Tuesday Sep th 14 - 1858
misty foggy with rain heading SW.
Payta headlands in sight on the weather quarter
Spoke the Barque spruce and ship Philadelphia

Wednesday Sep th 15 - 1858
Strong winds and foggy. Steering West -
unbent the cables and coiled them away
Saw humpbacks

Thursday Sep th 16 - 1858
Steering N by W. Saw sulphorbottoms lowered
and shot a bomb lance into one. Carpenter made
a rudder for the second mates boat

Friday Sep th 17 - 1858
Steering North took in the old starboard bowboat
Put a new one and fitted it for whaling

Lowered for blackfish took on board the
starboard quarterboat for repairs

Saturday September th 18 - 1858
Steering North mended the starboardboat
unbent the foret gallant sail and bent a new one

Sunday September th 19 - 1858
Steering N.W. W. Saw Porpoises at night
shortened sail and luffed up W by E
M M

Monday September th 20 - 1858
Steering N by N. until noon when we luffed
up to the wind heading N. Saw saw humpbacks
raised band at tacked ship and shortened sail

Tuesday September th 21 - 1858
Hoods and Chatham Island in sight saw seals
and Porpoises

Wednesday September 22 - 1858
on the starboard tack heading SW. Chatham hoods Chatham
and Althorn Island in sight saw finbacks and Porpoises
