Thursday September - 23 1858

Steering N. by N. Alhermar Island in sight
Saw finbackes and Blackfish lowered for the
Blackfish and took four

Friday September 24 1858

Lat 1.24 South - 65 miles west of Alhermar
on the starboard tack heading E. by N. at
daylight raised sperm whales lowered and
got two and commenced cutting them in
in the afternoon raised them again lowered but
did not fasten for Grace Blagden

Saturday September 25 - 1858

Fair weather with a light breeze on
the starboard tack saw finbackes and
blackfish: but up the gunk cleared up decks
and started the masts

Sunday Sep. 26 - 1858

on the starboard tack heading E. by N. trying
out of saw finbackes and Porpoises looked down
at night for

Monday September 27 - 1858

heading E. by N. Saw finbackes and Blackfish
cleared up and washed decks

Tuesday

Tuesday September 28 - 1858

heading E. by N. raised Alhermar Island at
two o'clock in the afternoon ahead, saw finbackes and
Porpoises. looped our oil Annie M. Nye

Annie M. Nye

Wednesday September 29 - 1858

heading E. by N. Alhermar and Harver Island
on the lee bow at noon kept away for North head
stowing down oil and cleared up decks

Saw finbackes and Porpoises Annie M. Nye

Thursday September 30 1858

This morning Southhead on the weather bow
hardup and run down past Harver Island
and luffed to the wind on the starboard tack saw rounder rock
saw blackfish and sulphur bottomns lowered for
blackfish did not fasten

Friday October 1 - 1858

on the starboard tack heading in for the lee bay
at noon spoke the barque ospray both tacked ship
off shore at four in the afternoon raised sperm whales
