Latitude 12 North Longitude 99.18 West
at daylight saw the barque aspray butting
a whale - Spoke the barque Leatitia with
a whale along side. We picked up a ~~dead~~
dead whale and but him in started the
works

Sunday October 3rd 1858
at daylight saw Albernard Island to the
Eastward at seven o'clock wore ship heading S.W.
saw finbackes: Boatmen finished building & washed ship

Monday October 4th 1858
Searing by the wind on the Starboard
tack heading E saw finbackes breaching
at night wore ship

Tuesday October 5th 1858
on the starboard tack heading East. Spoke the
Barque aspray and ship Galbonda. Saw
Albernard and ~~Barber~~ Islands. also finbackes
~~stowed down all and washed ship~~

Wednesday October 6th 1858
on the Starboard tack rainy and heavy fog
at daylight the Captain and mate came
aboard wore ship heading East. the Galbonda
and aspray in sight all day. raised finbackes
breaching at raised asail off the lee beam
standing to the S. South West.

Thursday October 7th 1858
on the Starboard tack heading East saw
Subporbottoms and two sail heading S.W.
four o'clock in the afternoon raised Albernard I.
at night tacked ship and shortened sail

Friday October 8th 1858
Strong Trades on the Starboard tack heading East
a comet in sight in the West. saw finbackes and humpbackes
at night got up to Albernard and tacked ship off shore

Saturday October 9th 1858
on the starboard tack heading East at daylight saw Albernard
raised finbackes and at night a comet at night wore ship
