at daylight Albermarle Island in sight
steering N.W. by E. saw the barque Osprey
at night saw Rodunder rock shortened sail
the Comet in sight at night

Monday October 11 - 1858
Steering E. N. E. in the morning Albatross
Rodunder rock in sight this morning, also the barque Osprey
saw finbacks and Sulphor bottoms raised Abington Island
in the afternoon: Unbent mended and sent up
~~main~~ fore top sail sent down the fore sail and
commenced work on that at ~~last~~ night laid it by for ^{next day}

Tuesday October 1st 12 - 1858
Steering on E. by N. Abington Island in sight
also Barque William Lee 24 months out 600 lbs
two school in the afternoon raised sperm whales
got one!! mended the fore sail and bent it

Thursday October -13- 1858 Out in
ocean whale but human ~~to~~ up and started the works
in the afternoon raised sperm whales lowered and got

Thursday
~~Friday~~ October 14 - 1858
finished boiling out one whale this morning
and but in the other. Cleared up decks and
started two cask of water at night. commenced
trying out

Friday October 15. 1858
got through trying out at ten o'clock this forenoon
raised Whales at four bells lowered and fastened
and lost him
on the starboard

Saturday October 16. 1858
on the larboard took heading 10 by S. Toward
Island on the lee quarter about ten miles off
hull fast, eight in the morning raised sperm
Whales lowered and got one took him alongside
cut him in cleared away the blubber and head and
