

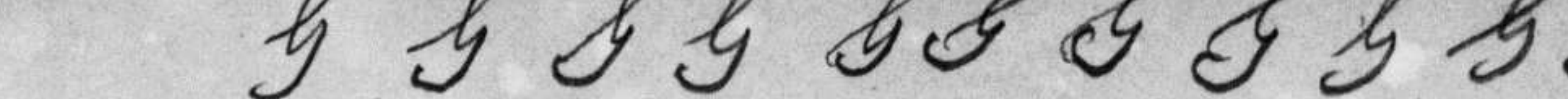
Monday October 18 - 1858.
on the Starboard tack heading S.W.
Seven o'clock in the morning raised Sperm whale
Lowered did not ~~fasten~~ got through trying out.

Tuesday October - 19 - 1858
breaking out and stowing down oil in the fore hold
Saw white water

Wednesday October 20-1958
on the last board tack heading W. S.W. finished
stowing down oil and washed ship

Thursday October 21 - 1854
on the Larboard tack heading S.W.
one o'clock raised Abington Winmans and Yower
Island passed & burque William Lee Stearing
on the wind ~~on~~ Starboard tack aboard

Friday October - 22 - 1858
at daylight Abbingdon Island on the weather bow
the ship being on the starboard tack heading S.W. by W. More
Ship to the eastward saw pinbecker. Spoke the Argue ospray
the comet in sight


 Saturday October - 23 - 1858
 on the starboard tack heading E. S. E. in the
 morning saw large osprey. Ghost hatched on
 the starboard tack in the comet in sight at night.

Sunday October 24 - 24 - 1858
Latitude 92° North. 89.24. West on the Starboard tack
Heading W. S.W. nine o'clock in the morning raised sperm
Whales lowered and got two: saw ship ~~going~~
Solomona took one whale G G G G G

Monday October 25 1858
 Commenced cutting in at daylight. got them on deck at noon
 Cleared away the heads but up the blubber and washed decks
 at night started the works & spoke the ship Solbonda
 trying out

Tuesday October 26 1858
Tying out: parted the main diagonal back stay
repaired and sent them up

Wednesday October - 27 - 1858
got through trying out, and washed decks one sail
in sight
