

Sunday November 4th - 1858.
on the Starboard tack heading E by S

Monday November 5th - 1858
This morning tacked ship to the Westward
White water at night tacked to the Eastward
Hauled up the courses

Tuesday November 6th - 1858
Steering N by W with fair wind, sent
down and overhauled the cutting blocks and
ropes at night luffed to on the starboard
tack with the main yard aback

Wednesday November 7th - 1858
Steering West. sent down and
overhauled the cutting pennants
at luffed to on the starboard tack

Thursday November 8th - 1858
on the starboard tack heading W. S. W.
overhauled the fore brace blocks and pennant

Friday November 9th - 1858
on the starboard tack heading N. by E
up the cutting pennants and blocks saw
Hood and Chatham Islands at night tacked ship

Saturday November 10th - 1858
on the starboard tack heading N. by E
Hood and Charles Islands in sight
Saw Blackfish

Sunday November 11th - 1858
on the starboard tack steering W. S. W. Charles
and Albermarl Island in sight
Saw cowfish

Monday November 12th - 1858
Steering N by W. Albermarl in sight setting
up the head staying stays. saw Blackfish lowered
did not fasten. lowered at night. Two boats fastened
and theirons drew out

Tuesday November 13th - 1858
on the starboard tack heading N. E.
raised south lead two o'clock in the afternoon
saw Porpoises and diamond fish
