Wednesday November 17 - 1858

at daylight saw Narver Island ~~run off~~
hept off past Narver at two in the afternoon
raised rounder rock. at night spoke the ship
Vektor 24 months out - 1100 lbs oil

Thursday November 18 - 1858

on the starboard tack heading East. Albermarl Island
ahead Rounder rock and ship Vektor on the lee Bow
raised Sperm whales lowered did not fasten. ship Vektor
took one whale

Friday November 19 - 1858

on the Starboard tack Albermarl Island
ahead at ten o'clock raised Vektor Bark Atlantic
and Rounder rock at night spoke the Vektor
and Atlantic. saw one ship on the lee beam saw
finbacks and Blackfish

Saturday November 20 - 1858

Steering N.E. by N. Albermarl on the
Starboard beam. four sail in sight
at night luffed to the wind on the
starboard tack with the main yard aback

Sunday November 21 - 1858. Abingdon

Sunday November 21 - 1858

~~this morning~~ ^{we} were around on the starboard
tack steering N.E. by N. two sail in sight
Albermarl on the starboard beam saw Grampuses
and white water ~~very~~ ^{very} beam saw

Monday November 22 - 1858

on the Starboard tack heading E. Abingdon
Island ahead. Albermarl on the starboard beam
eight o'clock in the morning raised sperm whales
lowered and got two got on board at night saw Grampuses

Tuesday November 23 - 1858

on the starboard tack heading N.E. Abingdon
Island ahead Albermarl on the weather beam two sail
on the weather quarter but in our whales blew away the
heads but the blubber into horsepicks and waked decks
started the works at night

Wednesday November 24 - 1858

on the starboard tack heading E. Abingdon Island on
the weather beam and a sail on the weather quarter
eight o'clock in the morning raised sperm whales
lowered did not fasten at night 4 sail in sight finished
tacking out
