Abbingdon four points on the weather bow
Stowing down oil half past seven in the morning
raised sperm whales two points on the lee bow
Lowered and got two and cut them in

Saturday December 4 - 1858
on the starboard tack heading E. Abbingdon on
the weather beam cleared ^{away} the heads but not the
blubber and started the works pumped one cask of water
two sails in sight spoke the Bark Atlantic

Sunday December 5 - 1858
on the starboard heading E by S
Abbingdon on the weather beam on sail
in sight heading to the westward trying out

Monday December 6 - 1858
on the starboard tack Abbingdon ahead
Binkow's Island on the weather beam got
through trying out. saw Blackfish

Tuesday December 7 - 1858
on the starboard tack Binkow's & Abbingdon Island
on the weather beam. James and Abernethy on
the weather bow one sail in sight

Wednesday December 8 - 1858
Binkow's and Abbingdon on the weather beam
Coopering and stowing down oil saw finbacks

Thursday December 9 - 1858
Eight o'clock in the morning tacked ship to the westward
Abbingdon on the lee bow Binkow's on the weather. saw finbacks
and Porpoises stowed down the remainder of our oil

Friday December 10 - 1858
on the starboard tack heading S.W. Watched ship
at noon Abbingdon 6 miles off on the weather beam
raised sperm whales lowered one boat fastened
and the iron drew

Saturday December 11 - 1858
Abbingdon and Abernethy Islands in sight.
saw finbacks
