Chatham Island and two sail in sight
saw white water

Friday December 31st 1858

on the starboard tack heading E. S. E. saw a
pinkie and two sail killed a pig and
washed ship

~~Saturday January 1st 1859~~

~~on the starboard tack heading E. by S. one
sail on the starboard tack seen in the afternoon
run off and spoke her~~

Saturday January 1st 1859

on the starboard tack heading E. by south
in the afternoon spoke the Bark Emity. N. B.
14 months out 400 bbls oil saw Grampuses and
Porpoises

Sunday January 2nd 1859

on the starboard tack spoke the Emity
at four in the afternoon raised
Chatham Island on the horizon

Monday P. Jan 3rd 1859

at daylight raised Chatham on
the horizon the Bark Emity in sight
dropped anchor ten o'clock in the forenoon
got things ready and cleared away three
boats and pulled around on the weather
side of the Island for tarapin ship Hector
came in and dropped anchor

Tuesday January 4th 1859

Lying at anchor in Hobbs bay Chatham
Island one boat came on board came on board
water and provisions

Wednesday January 5th 1859

Lying at anchor in Hobbs bay Chatham Is.
the men ashore for tarapin

Thursday January 6th 1859

Lying at anchor in Hobbs bay Chatham Island
the men on board the ship were poisoned
from eating tarapin meat one boat started
for our camp but had to put back on account
of being sick
