saw blackfish and porpoises at night
had some rain

Thursday Feb - 17 - 1859

on the starboard heading N.E. by N
the cooper setting up shooks lowered
for blackfish

Friday Feb - 18 - 1859

light winds on the starboard tack
the cooper set up one shook, scraped
the mast and skinned them

Saturday Feb - 19 - 1859

light winds from the S.E. on the
starboard tack. saw fin tracks and
blackfish

Sunday Feb - 20 - 1859

light winds on the starboard tack
saw porpoises and one sail steering
to the eastward

at daylight saw St. Clare Island and
one sail steering up the coast -
started bread and water set up seven
bark - at four o'clock got the anchors off
the bows. saw bone shanks

lying at anchor off Santa Clara
two o'clock hoisted sails and hove up
the anchor got of Turners point and
dropped anchor pushed light Sails - hoisted
off Mottapoissett - 9 - months out - 300 lbs oil
on board I see a man and a dog

Wednesday Feb - 23 - 1859

lying at anchor in Turners towed
araft of bark ashore and tiered them up
got awings up and commenced breaking
out oil - got four barrels sweet potatoes
I see a man happy by dog
