

Saturday March - 3 - 1859
at anchor off Tumbes point. took on
board one launch load of wood and stowed
it down. run down water and sheared up
decks at night took our spars on board

Sunday March - 6 - 1859
lying at anchor off Tumbes point
one boats crew ashore on leave
saw a Peruvian steamer under sail
steering up the coast

Monday March - 7 - 1859
this morning sent one boat up the
river with oil. the captain came on
board half past eleven. At 11. took our
anchor and ~~launched~~ put to sea bound to Payto

Tuesday March - 8 - 1859
light winds ~~and~~ ~~launched~~ made 14 miles
south - saw pinbacks at saw Cape Blanco

Wednesday March - 9 - 1859
passed Cape Blanco. painting ship
saw pinbacks ~~Philip and~~

Stan Thursday March - 10 - 1859

2 Thursday March - 10 - 1859 -
hard wind at night saw Payto head

Friday March - 11 - 1859
at day high Payto heads on the weather
beam. saw one sail bound in to Payto
got up to Payto and at light in the evening
let go the anchor and furled sails

Saturday March - 12 - 1859
at daylight mended the windlass
hoisted up the anchor towed to the ship in
and dropped anchor

~~Sunday~~ Sunday March - 13 - 1859 - the starboard watch
went ashore on liberty
