Wednesday - March - 16 - 1859
Lying at anchor in Payta harbour
Painting Ship one watch on liberty

Thursday March - 17 - 1859
Lying at anchor in Payta harbour
on watch on liberty the Joseph Meggs
Lying off and on

Friday March - 18 - 1859
Lying at anchor in Payta harbour one watch on leave
doing odd jobs

Sat - March - 19 - 1859
Washing and Painting the boats, & setting up
The head rigging exchanged 15 barrels potatoes with
Joseph Meggs

Lucy Nye age 65
Sunday March - 20 - 1859
the Joseph Meggs left here today
the mail Steamer and a Peruvian man-of-war
came in to ~~Lucy Nye age 65~~
Monday March 21 - 1859

the Bark Corser Lying off and on
took aboard 354 lbs sugar 20 sacks flour
the mail boat left today with the steamer
Lumber in tow Tuesday March 22 - 1859

Lying at anchor in Payta harbour - the carpenter
fitting an anchor stock took on board 4 sacks onions
2 sacks sugar one Peruvian man-of-war came in today
also a Peruvian Bark ~~Lane~~

Wednesday March 23 - 1859
got our anchor on the bows and cleared up decks
in the afternoon took our anchor and went to sea
passed a whaling bark bound in to Payta

Thursday March 24 - 1859
at daylight Payta heads in sight got two black ps
at night backed ship off shore
