N. W. by W. at work in the rigging
lowered for blackfish

Tuesday April 5 - 1859
on the starboard tack - Steering West by N
at work in the rigging and trying out blackfish

on the lee beam at night Spoke the Ship
Mary Ann

Wednesday April 6 - 1859
Steering N. W. by W. Woods Island in sight
and two sail in sight at work in the rigging

Thursday April - 7 - 1859
at daylight Woods Island on the
starboard beam in the afternoon saw
Charles Island lowered and got 2 blackfish
Spoke the Mary Ann

Friday April 8 - 1859
Steering S. E. Cleared away our blackfish
at work in the rigging saw the Mary Francis
trying out

Saturday April - 9 - 1859
light winds at Mary Francis astern
trying out tried out our blackfish at night
Spoke the Mary Ann bailing

Sunday April - 10 - 1859
on the starboard tack steering by the wind
Mary Ann on the lee bow bailing raised
Charles Island in the afternoon ahead

Steering N. W. by W. Charles Island
and South head in sight at work in the
rigging spoke the schooner Montero Ripley Capt
San finbacks and Porpoises

Tuesday April - 12 - 1859
at daylight South head on the

Ripley of Est had for flour running down
the Island saw finbacks at work in the
rigging
