

Wednesday July 6 - 1859
at night steering North. daylight heaved
to the wind on the starboard tack Ludpeper rock
ahead Winmans Island two points on the
weather bow one said on the weather quarter setting
up the main stay saw humpbacks

Thursday July 7 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack
at daylight Ludpeper rock two points ahead
and Winmans Island two points forward
the weather beam saw four sail at night spoke
the Barks Ospray and Montgomery. N.B.
started broad set up the main topmast degenant
and royal mast stays. saw humpbacks

Friday July 8 - 1859 steering by the
wind on the starboard tack three sail in sight
saw pinbacks and Blackfish one o'clock in
the afternoon raised Abington Island
three points on the weather bow

Saturday July 9 - 1859 steering by
the wind on the starboard tack Abington
Island four points on the weather bow five
sail in sight at night spoke the ship Napoleon
Barks Sonia and Octocota

Sunday July 10 - 1859

on the starboard tack five sail in sight Abington
Island Binkows Island on the weather bow
one o'clock in the afternoon spoke the Sonia

Monday July 11 - 1859
on the starboard tack heading S.E.
five sail in sight steering by the wind to the Eastward

Tuesday July 12 - 1859

on the starboard tack steering by the wind
saw pinbacks and Blackfish

Wednesday July 13 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack at daylight
raised a sperm whale. hauled and got him took
it alongside and got the ready and turned in
