

Thursday

July 14 - 1859

Laying To on the starboard tack commenced cutting at daylight: got the body aboard and made the head fast alongside

Friday July 15 - 1859

finished cutting the ^{up}huber at daylight hooked on and hove in the junk and hove up the case and bailed it

Saturday July 16 - 1859

on the starboard tack - steering by the wind ~~on the~~ started in cask of press water and three of salt water trying out - saw humpbacks and Porpoises

Sunday July 17 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack saw finbacks and Porpoises got through trying out at night

Monday

July 18 - 1859 steering by

wind on the starboard tack. this morning blew up deck and washed off ten casks in the forenoon saw Abington three points on the weather bow: at night saw ~~Winnans~~ and two said ~~Joos~~

Tuesday July 19 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack Abington and the N.E. Point of Akemast Island on the weather beam: saw two sail in sight steering to eastward

Wednesday July 20 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack heaving and stowing down oil

Thursday July 21 - 1859

on the starboard tack steering by the wind stowing down oil: saw finbacks and Porpoises

Friday July 22 - 1859

steering by the wind on the starboard tack finished stowing down at noon and in the afternoon washed ship
