

Saturday July 23 - 1859

Steering by the wind on the starboard tack took in and repaired the Mast boat. Saw finbackes and Porpoises

Sunday July 24 - 1859

Steering by the wind on the starboard tack Saw finbackes and Porpoises

Monday July 25 - 1859

Steering by the wind on the starboard tack. Started water. ran off once for white water - saw finbackes

Proportion July - 97 L 387

Tuesday July 26 - 1859

Steering by the wind on the starboard tack at noon wore ship to the westward steering by the wind untill night when we wore ship to the eastward saw finbackes and Porpoises

Wednesday July 27 - 1859

Steering by the wind on the starboard tack saw white water. at night wore ship

Thursday July 28 - 1859 yards braced up on the starboard tack. Steering East. Saw finbackes and a lone Shark. at night shortened sail

Friday July 29 - 1859 steering East Saw finbackes and Porpoises. at night shortened sail and wore ship

Saturday July 30 - 1859 on the starboard tack steering East. at three o'clock in the afternoon raised Cape. Saw Sorensen one point on the starboard bow. at night wore around off shore with the fore top sail aback

Sunday July 31 - 1859

at daylight kept off and squared the yards steering E. N. E. eleven o'clock in the forenoon raised Cape San Francisco two points on the starboard bow. Sounded for humpbackes. saw Blackfish and one sail. at night braced around the yards and wore ship off shore

Monday August 1 - 1859

at daylight kept off and squared the yards seven o'clock raised the land ahead. saw humpbackes and two sail. at night dropped anchor off Point Salera
