Saturday September 10 - 1857
41" South - 84-24" West at daylight Cloudy
with a light breeze from the South. saw Bluefish
and Porpoises. Boke out Sugar-Sugar and
Coera

Sunday September 11 - 1859
Lat 1. 24' south Lon 82. 52' West strong breeze
Steering by the wind on the Starboard tack
saw finbacks and Porpoises

Monday September 14 - 1837
Lat 2.26 south Lon 81.26 west Breeze with
a strong breeze. Steaming by the wind on the
starboard tack heading E. S. E. at Noxhall
dry starting water and sails clearing up and
standing off the foreboke bent a new fore top stay sail

Tuesday September - 19 - 1854.
at daylight made land on the lee beam steering
by the wind on the Starboard tack. saw humpbacks.
made Santa Clara hump first P.M. bearing S. E. by S
at night came to and dropped anchor between
S. Clara and Fairlee
