

Wednesday September 14 - 1859
at daylight ~~hove~~ up our anchor and got
under way for Yumbex Point. Eberm took
towed a raft of barks up the river and filled it
Eberm sailed at anchor of ~~Point~~ Yumbex Point

Thursday September 15 - 1859
Lying at anchor at anchor of Yumbex Point
towed a raft of water of and hoisted it
in. Painted the larboard bends and chains

Friday September 16 - 1859
Lying at anchor off Yumbex Point
washed and painted the bends on the starboard
side; took on board 50 lbs. Shooks from the
bark Eben Dodge; three loads of wood from
shore.

Saturday September 17 - 1859
Lying at anchor off Yumbex Point
stowing down water and took on board
15 lbs Potatoes - 25 lbs oil for Panto

Sunday September 18 - 1859
Half Past nine ~~AM~~ got under way for Panto
at night Point Mal Pelto 10 miles to the toward

Monday September 19 - 1859
repairing a boat. Saw bone shaker Paspoises
and three sail at night Cape Blanco 15 miles
to windward

Tuesday September 20 - 1859
at five o'clock H. M. took ship on shore
made land 10 miles to the windward of Cape Blanco
Saw pinbacks Blackfish three sail and
a steamer with barge in tow at night
Point Perena 12 miles to the windward

Wednesday September 21 - 1859
at daylight heading in shore steering
by the wind. seven o'clock A. M. raised
Point Perena ahead saw two two frigates
and two steamers. four o'clock P. M.
got in and dropped anchor. pushed sails
