 Remarks Saturday Nov 10th 1860
 Fore part strong breeze from the Northward
 steering S E by E by E the watch employees
 making scrub broom with picking up spun
 yarn & got out some water & saw a new
 wheel Road middle part moderating
 turned the reefs out of the Top Sails & set
 Main Top Gall Sail heavy swell continued
 Lat by Obs 22° 07' N
 Long by Chron 35m 27' W

Remarks Sunday Nov 11th
 Fore part fresh breeze from the Northward
 steering S E by E by E brook out & started some
 meat peeled onions for pickling & middle
 part the wind hauling gradually round to the
 S W latter part strong breeze with flying
 clouds & many sail strong indications of rain
 Lat by Obs 31m 31' N
 Long by Chron 33' W

Remarks Monday Nov 12th
 Fore part strong breeze from the S W & Sward
 steering S E by E by E, with passing clouds
 nothing in sight middle part continues
 much the same latter rather squally
 Lat by Obs 30m 42' N
 Long by Chron 49m 32' W

Remarks Tuesday Nov 13th
 Fore part strong breeze from the S W steering
 S E by E by E employed peeling onions for
 pickling & one sail in sight on the lar
 Bow at 7 P M steering S E by E middle part
 squally with rain latter part fine weather
 with strong breeze at S, S. W, two sails in sight
 Lat by Obs 29m 18' N
 Long by Chron 6m 15' W

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 Bound to the Pacific Ocean on a Whaling Voyage
 Remarks Wednesday Nov 14th 1860
 Fore part fresh breeze at S W steering
 S E by E, one sail in sight after dinner
 peeling Onions for pickling & c at 3 P M
 the breeze slackening up set Main Top Gall Sail
 & 2 fobs middle part squally with rain
 latter part blowing strong in squally
 put two reefs in the S Top Sail & on in
 the Main frequent rain squally
 Lat by Obs 29m 23' N
 Long by Chron 43m 25' W

Remarks Thursday Nov 15th
 Fore part strong breeze at S W with frequent
 rain squally steering S E by E, two sails in
 sight employed peeling Onions at 6 P M
 had more rain middle cleared off &
 became more moderate at daylight
 turned the reefs out the S Sails latter
 part five employees getting one potato
 on deck for an airing & c
 Lat by Obs 28m 49' N
 Long by Chron 46m 00' W

Remarks Friday Nov 16th
 Fore part fresh breeze from the S W hauling
 more to the S at 7 P M heading E S E,
 with cloudy weather middle & latter
 parts moderate employed getting
 out fresh water overhauling bottles
 & c
 Lat by Obs 28m 48' N
 Long by Chron 38m 30' W
