Remarks Sunday Nov 25th
Fore part strong breeze at E heading S, S E,
double reefed the top sails middle & latter
parts continue much the same
Lat by Obs 18^h 04^m S
Long by Chron 18^h 10^m W

Remarks Monday Nov 26th
Fore part strong double reefed top sail
breeze heading S E by S & S E saw
nothing middle & latter parts much
the same Lat by Obs 16^h 44^m S
Long by Chron 27^h 02^m W

Remarks Tuesday Nov 27th
Fore part strong traces heading S E & S E
by S, took out water washed ship some &
one sail in sight to windward middle
& latter parts continue much the
same Lat by Obs 13^h 24^m S
Long by Chron 25^h 44^m W

Remarks Wednesday Nov 28th
Fore part strong traces at E N E with
hazy weather saw a Hump Back & two
falls at 7 A.M. took a ship to the N, at 3 P.M.
took a back at daylight saw bears when
dist 30 miles got abreast of the S E point at
12 P.M. when it died away calm Lat by Obs 14^h 48^m S
Long by Chron 24^h 41^m W

The Pacific Ocean on a Whaling Voyage 9
Remarks Thursday Nov 29th 1860
Fore part light baffling wind saw bearing
E dist 4 miles saw a number of Hump
Backs lowered & tried to shoot one but
did not succeed middle part squally
Latter part strong breeze at 7 A.M. at
day bon N E dist 40 miles two ships in
sight Lat by Obs 14^h 04^m N
Long by Chron 23^h 30^m W

Remarks Friday Nov 30th
Fore part strong breeze spoke the *Endeavour*
of New Bedford Capt Fisher 1 mo out clear
had a game the ship heading S E by S, S E,
middle & latter parts fine weather steering
I saw nothing Lat by Obs 12^h 05^m S
Long by Chron 22^h 55^m W

Remarks Saturday Dec 1st
Fore part fine breeze & pleasant steering I
had another game with the *Endeavour*
after 4 P.M. middle part steering S, S E,
Latter part much the same Lat by Obs 10^h 06^m S
Long by Chron 21^h 48^m W

Remarks Sunday Dec 2nd
Fore part fine traces at E, N E, steering S, S E,
with fine weather employed heaving out
for Cod Fish Beans Rice & water saw a Hump
Back middle part manoeuvring latter part
the wind very light Lat by Obs 8^h 54^m S
Long by Chron 20^h 50^m W

Remarks Monday Dec 3rd
Fore part the traces about done the wind very
light middle & latter parts much the same
saw B Fish at aack Lat by Obs 8^h 14^m S
Long by Chron 20^h 10^m W
