Remarks Sunday Jan 20th 1860
Fore part fresh breeze from the N.E. steering W by S
saw some jumping at sundown took in sail
middle part light breeze at daylight the
wind breezed up latter part strong gale steering
W S W the water beginning to change green
Lat by Obs 36° 57' 8"

Remarks Monday Jan 21st
Fore part strong gale from the N.E. shifted to
the wind heading to the N.W. with cloudy
weather at 4 P.M. the wind dying away & D
visible with rain saw a Brig standing to
the Eastward middle part breezing on at 11 P.M.
the wind hauling round to the S.W. blowing
heavy latter part a Gale laying to near close
ruffled Main Top Sail & Top Mast Stay Sail & Main Gun
at 9 A.M. was ship to the Westward
Lat by Obs 37° 06' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 22' 20"

Remarks Tuesday Jan 22nd
Fore part the Gale rather moderating at the
Fore stay Sail & a close ruffled Top Sail at 6 P.M.
was ship heading E.S.E. the wind hauling
round more to the Southward the E.C. Gones
on the lubber's distant 3 miles middle
part the wind light latter part the same steering
N.E. Eastward
Lat by Obs 37° 23' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 41' 20"

Remarks Wednesday Jan 23rd
Fore part light breeze from S.E. steering E.N.E.
at sundown took in sail middle part breezing
on latter part strong double ruffled breeze from
the N.W. heading to the N.N.E.
Lat by Obs 37° 09' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 35' 20"

a Whaling Voyage to the Pacific Ocean
Remarks Thursday Jan 24th 1861
Fore part strong Gale from the Northward heading
to the E.N.E. with frequent rain & squally at sundown
took in sail heading N.E. by E middle part much
the same latter part strong breeze from the Westward
steering N.N.W. the wind hauling gradually to
the Southward
Lat by Obs 36° 35' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 20'

Remarks Friday Jan 25th
Fore part fresh breeze from the Southward steering
N.N.W. saw some new Main Braces at 5 P.M.
the wind hauling round to the S.E. at sunset
took in sail & shifted to the wind heading N.E.
by E cloudy weather middle part the wind hauling
round to the Northward & moderating latter part
light breeze one sail in sight Lat by Obs 36° 00' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 00' 00"

Remarks Saturday Jan 26th
Fore part light breeze from the N.W. hauling to the
Southward & breezing up at 4 P.M. strong breeze was
ship to the N.W. at sundown took in sail heading
W by S with hazy weather saw a number of Swallow
this afternoon middle part fine latter part calm
Lat by Obs
Long by Chron

Remarks Sunday Jan 27th
Fore part calm at 5 P.M. took a light breeze from
the E.N.E. heading S.E. at sundown took in sail
& was ship saw nothing but some porpoises to day
toward the fore part middle part breezing on latter part
strong breeze at N.W. at 9 A.M. saw Spinner Whales
two or three & chased got close on to two large whales
which they went down went aboard & got dinner quite
a number of large whales to windward Lat by Obs 36° 45' 8"
Long by Chron 32° 28' 00"
