

Back Nahitua Seas Capt Howland of Johnston
Remarks Fri Apr 26th 1861

Gore part a fresh breeze from the S, S E, heading to the Eastward variously employed Middle & latter parts the wind light employed scraping & rainishing the Sides, &c. Lat by Obs

Remarks Sat Apr 27th

Gore part light air from the S E bore ship to the S W employed scraping the Chances &c saw a number of pieces of Spine pass the Ship Middle & latter parts light variable breeze & calms sent down the Spanker & cut some off the foot
Lat by Obs 27th 15 W

Remarks Sun Apr 28th

Gore part light air from the Westward heading to the N furnished the Spanker & bent at saw nothing this day took in light Sail at dark Middle part much the same latter part light breeze from the South steering to the Northward
Lat by Obs 26th 46 S

Remarks Mond Apr 29th

Gore part the wind from the S E heading to the W the Islands of St Felix & Ambrose in sight on the sea bore at dark took in Sail & bore ship to the S E the Islands on the sea bore at 25 miles Middle & latter parts wind & weather much the same at 11 A M three Boats went in Fishing at the Island of St Felix the Ship running down under the lee of the Island
Lat by Obs 26th 16 S

steering to the Northward looking for whales
Remarks Tues Apr 30th 1861

Gore part fine breeze from the S E the Ship laying by off the Island about sun down the Boat came off caught about 200 fish brace forward heading E, N E, Middle & latter parts calm
Lat by Obs 26th 08 S

Remarks Wed May 1st

Gore part light air & calms employed scraping & painting the Chances &c Middle & latter parts light breeze from the S W steering S E Lat by Obs 26th 35 S
Long by Chron 78th 43 W

Remarks Thurs May 2nd

Gore part fine breeze from the S W, steering S E at 2 P M squared the yards steering E the wind hauling to the W, employed scraping & painting the Spar work at sun down took in sail the weather look squally Middle part the same latter part steering E N E fine weather
Lat by Obs 27th 13 S

Remarks Fri May 3rd

Gore part fine breeze from the N E steering E, N E, at 2 P M hauled up N E employed scraping & painting the Spar work Middle & latter parts much the same Long by Chron 78th 00 W Lat by Obs 26th 30

Remarks Sat May 4th

Gore part light breeze from the S E heading to the N E, employed as above Middle & latter parts light winds & calms saw plenty of Grampuses &c
Lat by Obs 27th 05 S
Long by Chron 74th 25 W
