

Bark. *Natiana* Sears of Dartmouth Capt. Howland
Remarks *Tues* May 14th 1861

Fore part light air from the Eastward steering to the North cloudy weather employed breaking out between decks for coal &c took in light sails & hauled up the courses at dark. Micele & Lutter parts much the same employed repairing the Fore-sail

Remarks *Wednesday* May 15th

Fore part light air from the SE steering N & finishing the Fore-sail & bent it at dark took in top-sail & sent one sail in sight ahead Micele & Lutter parts calm employed repairing the Main-top-sail No Obs

Remarks *Thursday* May 16th

Fore part calm employed at the N & Sail finishing & bent it at 4 P.M. Micele & Lutter parts much the same Land in sight dist 30 miles

Remarks *Friday* May 17th

Fore part light variable air steering to the Northward Micele & Lutter parts much the same employed scrubbing Ship outside Lat by Obs 19° 22' S

Remarks *Saturday* May 18th

Fore part light air from the Westward steering NW employed washing Ship the Land in sight Micele & Lutter parts the wind & weather much the same Lat by Obs 18° 31' S Long by Chron 71° 15' W

steering to the Northward making for Whales
Remarks *Sunday* May 19th 1861

Fore part light winds & calms steering W, NW, from scrubbing Ship & took out for water but took &c caught a Green Fish today. Hundreds of Fin Backs in sight & a very quantity of Port Micele part the wind light Lutter part hugging up some & huffing with cloudy weather & some rain No Obs

Remarks *Monday* May 20th

Fore part a fine breeze from the Southward steering NW by W with cloudy weather saw two Sails Micele & Lutter parts squally with rain saw two Green Fish Lat by Obs 17° 23' S

Remarks *Tuesday* May 21st

Fore part a light breeze from the E steering NW, with cloudy weather & some rain at dark took in the light Sails hauled up the Courses & huffed to the wind heading S W the Land in sight this day Micele part the same Lutter part fine breeze at S E steering W, NW, with cloudy weather Lat by Obs 17° 28' S

Remarks *Wednesday* May 22nd

Fore part fresh SE breeze steering W, NW, with cloudy weather saw a school of Black Fish going quick to windward Micele & Lutter parts wind & weather much the same saw some Green Fish & plenty of Fin Backs Lat by Obs 16° 20' S

Remarks *Thursday* May 23rd

Fore part fine breeze at SE steering W, NW, with cloudy weather saw the Land on the Sea Breeze employed fitting a new Boat for a Mast Boat drawing & Knotting Gains &c, Micele part the wind moderating Lutter part light breeze
