Remarks Sunda Aug 10th 1861

Bore past a moderate breeze from the N.E. heading
N.W. employed at ship's duty. Middle & latter
parts the wind light variable & ship's in sight
Long by Chron 91st 06 W Lat by Obs 19th 38 E,

Remarks Sunda Aug 11th

Bore past light air from the Southward heading
to the Eastward air as a moderate breeze Middle & latter
parts much the same Lat by Obs 19th 35 E

Remarks Sunda Aug 12th

Bore past light winds & variable Middle & latter parts
light winds & calm Long by Chron 91st 08, Lat by Obs 19th 32 E

Remarks Sunda Aug 13th

Bore past light winds & calm employed fitting some
new S.P. masts &c the Healy in sight. Middle
past calm at 10 A.M. took a light breeze from the E.N.E.
at 10 P.M. saw the Healy's boat down shortly after we saw
a sperm whale bowing away the foreboard boat struck
Lat by Obs 19th 40 Long by Chron 91st 35 W

Remarks Sunda Aug 14th

Bore past about calm killed the whale and got him
long piece at 3 P.M. got dinner got ready for
cutting & hooked on cut off his head & cut on his
body finished at 12 P.M. called all hands at
daylight hooked on & cut in the head got it in
at 11 A.M. clear away & started the work
Lat by Obs 19th 38 E Long by Chron 91st 28 W

cruising on the Archer Grounds

Remarks Sunda Aug 15th 1861

Bore past calm employed boiling (boiling cascading)
at 6 P.M. took a light breeze from E.S.E. hoisted
the S. Tails & wore ship heading S.E. ship's in sight
Middle & latter parts light winds & calm employed
boiling & cutting up fish Long by Chron 91st 22 W Lat by Obs 19th 44 S

Remarks Sunda Aug 16th

Bore past light winds from the N.E. heading to the
E.S.E. employed boiling at dark took in light sails
& wore ship & ship's in sight. Middle past much
the same latter part took a strong breeze from the
S.W. with rain in squalls would ship's in sight
Long by Chron 91st 24 W Lat by Obs 19th 38 S

Remarks Sunda Aug 17th

Bore past strong breeze from the S.W. steering to the N.E.
employed boiling at 4 P.M. heaved to the wind
heading W. by S at dark under reefed the S. Tails &
found the fore sail Middle & latter parts the wind
& weather much the same finished boiling
Lat by Obs 19th 32 E Long by Chron 91st 09 W

Remarks Sunda Aug 18th

Bore past strong breeze from E.S.E. heading S. the employed
starting meat out of Sides into barrels breaking out
for water &c the whale turned up about S.E. by S
Middle & latter parts fresh breeze the Healy in sight.

Remarks Sunda Aug 19th

Bore past a fresh breeze from E.S.E. heading S. at 5 P.M.
spoke the Healy heading S.E. after wearing ship
Middle & latter parts much the same employed starting
down in the fore hold started a piece off -
Lat by Obs 19th 03 E Long by Chron 91st 18 W
