

Bark Matilda Vears Capt Howland of Dartmouth
 Remarks *Guana* Oct 22nd 1861
 Fore part light breeze from E Eastward steering W by S
 at 3 P.M. hauled her up N.W. & for South Head hook out
 water & c. Middle part heading to the Southward
 latter part steering N.E. with very light winds &
 a strong current setting to the Westward

Remarks *Manua* Oct 23rd
 Fore part very light air from the S.E. steering N.E.
 with hazy weather saw land on the Sea Bore
 the Island of Abamaal tacked off shore at 10 P.M.
 tacked in again at 2 A.M. latter part the wind very
 light saw 3 Fish bones without success

Remarks *Guana* Oct 24th
 Fore part light air from S.E. steering in for South Head
 at 3 miles heading E by N 3 miles in sight &
 plenty of Backs Middle part the same latter part
 fine breeze from E Eastward at 10 A.M. two boats went
 in to South Head fishing 4 ships in sight Lat by Obs 00 44 S

Remarks *Guia* Oct 25th
 Fore part fresh breeze at 2 P.M. the boats came on
 board found no fish heading to the S.W. saw
 a Bark Boiling Middle & latter parts moderate
 at 9 A.M. kept her off N.W. & Head bearing E

Remarks *Satuna* Oct 26th
 Fore part a fine breeze from the S steering N.W.
 6 ships in sight saw boats down about sundown
 8 or 10 miles off hook out for Meat Sugar Vinegar
 Soda Apples & c. middle & latter parts moderate
 running off to the Northward several ships in
 sight

Cruising about the Gallapagos Islands
 Remarks *Guana* Oct 27th 1861
 Fore part a moderate breeze from the South steering
 for Round Island at 1 1/2 P.M. two boats went in
 fishing came off at sundown caught a fine
 lot of Fish middle & latter parts moderate
 Long by Chron 92 13 W Lat by Obs 00 28 S

Remarks *Manua* Oct 28th
 Fore part a light breeze from S.E. heading to
 the Eastward the land in sight on the Head Bore
 two ships in sight to windward Middle & latter
 parts moderate standing in shore 4 ships in sight
 Long by Chron 92 00 W Lat by Obs 00 20 S

Remarks *Guana* Oct 29th
 Fore part a fresh breeze from the Southward standing
 in shore at 4 P.M. tacked off at 5 P.M. spoke the
 Flotta of New Bedford Capt Hussey 17 mo out 300 bbls
 middle & latter parts standing in shore
 Lat by Obs 00 05 South

Remarks *Manua* Oct 30th
 Fore part moderate breeze from the S heading
 in shore for Abingdon at 4 P.M. tacked off
 heading N.W. with hazy weather employed
 making Open Yarn & c. several ships in sight
 middle & latter parts continue moderate
 Long by Chron 93 00 W Lat by Obs 00 17 S

Remarks *Guana* Oct 31st
 Fore part moderate breeze from S heading W by S
 had very quantity of Fish Backs employed making
 Open Yarn landed the W Boat middle Middle
 & latter parts light winds & calm part of
 the Backs in sight Lat by Chron 18 S
