Fore part light air & calms heading to the Westward
at 4 P.M. lashed ship to the Eastward employed
at ship's duty the Carpenter repairing & old Boat
middle & latter parts continue moderate
Long by Chron 93^h 10^m 11^s Lat by Obs 00^h 24^m 8^s

Remarks Satua Nov 2nd

Fore part light breeze from S.E. heading to the
S.W. at 3 P.M. raised a school of Spinn Whales
going quick to the Northward at 4 P.M. however
& chased at sundown when they went down
close to the Boat if we could have day light
enough for one more rising in all probability
we should struck Middle part light air heading
to the Eastward Middle & latter parts light
breeze & Calms one sail in sight Lat by Obs 00^h 15^m 8^s

Remarks Suna Nov 3rd

Fore part light breeze from S.E. heading to
the S.W. employed fitting a new Boat &c at dusk
had a gam with the E. Corning of New Bedford
Capt Stetson 60 lbs since leaving Sella middle
& latter parts continue moderate
Long by Chron 97^h 00^m 11^s Lat by Obs 00^h 12^m 8^s

Remarks Monu Nov 4th

Fore part light breeze from S.E. heading to
the S.W. the Corning in sight on the weather Board
middle & latter parts continue moderate
put out a new Boat on the Tackboard cranes
& put the L Boat on the Bow cranes
Long by Chron 98^h 34^m 11^s Lat by Obs 00^h 35^m 8^s

Howland bound off Shore for a cruise
Remarks Tuesa Nov 5th 1861

Fore part a moderate breeze from S.E. heading
S.W. employed at ship's duty middle &
latter parts continue moderate
Long by Chron 99^h 00^m 11^s Lat by Obs 01^h 09^m 8^s

Remarks Wednesa Nov 6th

Fore part a moderate breeze from E.S.E. still
N.W. any quantity of S. Backs in sight
employed at ship's duty middle & latter
parts about calm Long by Chron Lat by Obs

Remarks Thursa Nov 7th

Fore part a light breeze from S.E. heading
S.W. employed repairing a stove middle part
fresh breeze latter part moderate
Long by Chron 101^h 14^m 11^s Lat by Obs 01^h 33^m 8^s

Remarks Frid Nov 8th

Fore part moderate breeze from S.E. heading
S.W. employed sitting up the Main Mast
at Sun down said B. Back lowered without success
middle & latter parts fresh breeze with brizely
rain at intervals employed repairing the Boat
Long by Chron 102^h 15^m 11^s Lat by Obs 02^h 39^m 8^s

Remarks Satua Nov 9th

Fore part fresh breeze from S.E. heading S.W.
employed variously foggy & brizely at intervals
middle & latter parts strong breeze
Long by Chron 103^h 11^m 11^s Lat by Obs 03^h 39^m 8^s

Remarks Suna Nov 10th

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. heading S.W.
plenty of Ship Jacks around the Ship middle &
latter parts much the same
Long by Chron 103^h 54^m 11^s Lat by Obs 03^h 11^m 8^s
