Fore part fresh breeze from S.E. tacked ship to the
E. N.E. fine weather nothing in sight had a look
Midace & latter parts much the same at 10
A.M. tacked to the E. N.E. took out water
Long by Chron 10338 W. Lat by Obs 4133 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 12th*

Fore part strong breeze at S.E. heading E. N.E.
at 5 P.M. tacked ship to the S. & N. saw nothing
this day Midace & latter parts wind &
weather squally Long by Chron 10411 W. Lat by Obs 5111 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 13th*

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. steering N at 5
P.M. raised a school of sperm whales bowled the
S. Boat struck about 5 took the whale long side
at 6 P.M. & got ready for cutting Midace & latter
parts squally calmed all hands at daylight
bore ship & hooked on to the whale to land
quite rugged got his head off & Bray in at 12

Remarks *Sunda Nov 14th*

Fore part strong breeze with rain squally got the
head in bled the case got it overboard & bore ship
at 4 P.M. to the S. started the works & cleaned up
sicks &c Midace & latter parts fresh breeze
employed Boiling John a Portuguese we shipped
in Tombez off duty with the Vinerias
Diseas ben off duty now a week the Cook has ben
sick off duty for three weeks with some motion
own Disease saw a whale beach about 12 o'clock
a long wait off did not see him after

Cruising on the Off Shore Ground
Remarks *Sunda Nov 15th 1861*

Fore part fine breeze from E. S.E. & good weather
employed Boiling started a bl of Beef at 6 P.M.
P.M. bore ship to the S. & N. set the watch Midace
& latter parts wind & weather much the same
finished Boiling the Barber & got the Fat Lean
on to Boil Long by Chron 104137 W. Lat by Obs 4133 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 16th*

Fore part fine breeze from the Eastward heading
to the S. finished Boiling & cleaned up Sicks
started a Ninety of Beef into Barrels &c Midace
& latter parts moderate employed storing down
Long by Chron 105 W. Lat by Obs 4144 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 17th*

Fore part moderate breeze from S.E. heading to the
E. S.E. all hands employed storing down in the
Fore hold stowed down 44 bls about 70 on deck
the whale made about 5 to 6 bls all together
Midace & latter parts fresh breeze & quite rugged
Long by Chron 104131 W. Lat by Obs 4149 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 18th*

Fore part strong breeze from the S.E. with rugged
weather plenty of fine backs in sight at
4 P.M. bore ship to the S. & N. Midace & latter
parts much the same employed storing down the
remainder of the Oil breaking out shook heads
&c Long by Chron 104147 W. Lat by Obs 4139 S

Remarks *Sunda Nov 19th*

Fore part strong breeze from S.E. heading to the S.E. & N.
employed breaking out for Shocks storing off the
hold & finished & washed off Midace & latter
parts much the same employed setting up Shocks
&c Long by Chron 104152 W. Lat by Obs 4148 S
