 Fore part light breeze at 12 o'clock tacked ship
 to the N^W by E passed close to the E. Corning
 employed repairing the main top gallant sail
 pinsailed & bent it saw no whales of any kind
 Midace & latter parts much the same
 Long by Chron 108° 08' W Lat by Obs 41° 40' S

Remarks Satura Jan 18th
 Fore part moderate employed sitting up
 the fore rigging at 3 P. M. saw 3 fish low
 & struck & saved two the Bow & Waist Boats
 one each the Starboard Boat lost her sail
 at dark spoke the E. Corning 10th 11th this
 season midace & latter parts moderate
 employed sitting up the main rigging
 4 ships in sight

Remarks Sunda Jan 19th
 Fore part light breeze heading N^W by N
 at 3 P. M. spoke the Norman of Nantucket
 1 mo out 200 Blk Capt Gidd Midace & latter
 parts moderate saw Black Fish & Crumpons
 Long by Chron 107° 38' W Lat by Obs 41° 32' S

Remarks Mona Jan 20th
 Fore part light breeze tacked ship to the S^W by E
 fine weather one sail in sight midace
 & latter parts much the same
 Long by Chron Lat by Obs 41° 34'

Remarks Sunda Jan 21th
 Fore part fresh breeze had some rain squally
 heading N^W by E passed out the Black Fish
 made about a 100 of Oil Midace & latter parts
 much the same employed at ship's duty
 Long by Chron 108° 08' W Lat by Obs 41° 00' S

cruising on the off shore Ground
 Remarks Kanesa Jan 22nd 1862
 Fore part strong breeze the ship on the Southern
 tack at dark tacked heading N^W by E Midace
 & latter parts much the same
 Long by Chron 108° 08' W Lat by Obs 41° 45' S

Remarks Chusa Jan 23rd
 Fore part fresh breeze heading to the N^W by E
 employed at ship's duty at 6 P. M. tacked
 ship to the S^W by E Midace & latter parts the same
 Long by Chron 107° 43' W Lat by Obs 41° 22' S

Remarks Enid Jan 24th
 Fore part strong breeze heading N^W by E employed
 at ship's duty saw a flock of killing midace
 & latter parts strong breeze the ship in sight
 Long by Chron 107° 43' W Lat by Obs 41° 19' S

Remarks Satura Jan 25th
 Fore part strong breeze tacked ship to the N^W by E
 employed at ordinary duty Midace & latter
 parts much the same saw Black Fish
 Long by Chron 106° 31' W Lat by Obs 41° 40' S

Remarks Sunda Jan 26th
 Fore part strong breeze heading N^W by E employed
 sitting up the main topmast rigging two ships
 in sight Midace & latter parts moderate
 Lat by Obs 41° 49' S

Remarks Mona Jan 27th
 Fore part fine weather midace & latter parts
 strong breeze heading to the Southward
 Long by Chron 107° 36' W Lat by Obs 41° 27' S
