

Back Nahla's Chase of Dartmouth Capt. Crowland  
Remarks Frid Feb 7<sup>th</sup> 1862

Fore part light breeze from S.E. heading to the Eastward one ship in sight at 5 P.M. saw B Fish low in away the S Boat got two the other Boats one each Middle & latter parts continue moderate employed clearing away B Fish cleaning Blubber &c  
Long by Chron 108° 102' W Lat by Obs 41° 35' S

Remarks Saturd Feb 8<sup>th</sup>

Fore part moderate breeze from S.E. started ship to the S.W. started the work after dinner saw several schools of Porpoises one sail in sight at sundown at 8 P.M. spoke the Louisiana Middle & latter parts moderate  
Long by Chron 108° 28' W Lat by Obs 37° 12' S

Remarks Sun Feb 9<sup>th</sup>

Fore part moderate heading S.E. by E saw some Finbacks employed heaving out for meat Bread &c Middle & latter parts equally one sail in sight & some Finbacks  
Long by Chron 108° 11' W Lat by Obs 41° 33' S

Remarks Mond Feb 10<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong breeze with rain squalls heading to the Southward Middle & latter parts the same two sails in sight

Remarks Tues Feb 11<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong breeze Middle part moderating latter part fine weather saw some B Backs  
Long by Chron 108° 39' W Lat by Obs 37° 31' S

Cruising on the Off Shore Ground

Remarks Wed Feb 12<sup>th</sup> 1862

Fore part fresh breeze heading S.E. by E at 2 P.M. lashed ship to the S.W. saw some B Backs employed at ships duty Middle & latter parts moderate  
Long by Chron 108° 12' W Lat by Obs 37° 11' S

Remarks Thurs Feb 13<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light wind at S.E. heading S.E. two ships in sight employed mauling & mauling the Dead Eyes &c Middle & latter parts the same

Long by Chron 107° 53' W Lat by Obs 37° 17' S

Remarks Frid Feb 14<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light wind & fine weather heading to the Southward two sails in sight saw some B Fish going quick Middle & latter parts much the same employed painting the Iron work aloft setting up the Foretopmast Riggings &c

Remarks Saturd Feb 15<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light wind from S.E. heading to the Eastward Middle & latter parts much the same  
Long by Chron 106° 30' W Lat by Obs 41° 30' S

Remarks Sun Feb 16<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light variable wind from S.E. to S at 2 P.M. spoke the Louisiana had a game middle part rainy latter part the same

Remarks Mond Feb 17<sup>th</sup>

Fore part squally with rain spoke the Roscoe of New Bedford 900 spurs & hump backs Middle part breezing double humped the Foretop sail Middle & latter parts the same  
Lat 37° 13' S
