Remarks Wanda Mar 12th 1862
Fore part strong breeze from the North with rain
squalls stirring & by N employed washing
Ship & Middle & Latter parts much the
same Long by Chron 99° 23' W Lat by Obs 34° 13' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 13th
Fore part strong gales the wind hauling
from N to S W blowing on at 3 P M took in
the Topgallant sail & double reefed the
Fore & Main stunsails & by N had rain in
squalls Middle part moderating made
Sail Latter part strong breeze
Long by Chron 95° 48' W Lat by Obs 34° 32' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 14th
Fore part strong breeze from S W stirring
& by N quite rugged Middle & Latter parts
much the same
Long by Chron 93° 11' W Lat by Obs 34° 39' S
Fore part strong breeze from S W stirring & by N
middle part the wind hauling more to the
N W Latter part the same
Long by Chron 90° 32' W Lat by Obs 34° 41' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 15th
Fore part strong breeze from N W stirring
& by N employed at Ship's duty Middle
& Latter parts much the same
Long by Chron 86° 38' W Lat by Obs 34° 30' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 17th
Fore part strong gales from N W stirring
& by N, Middle & Latter parts much the
same employed washing Ship
Long by Chron 83° 21' W Lat by Obs 34° 32' S

Howland bound to Salabuan
Remarks Wanda Mar 18th 1862
Fore part a fine breeze from N W stirring
& by N employed scrubbing Ship &c
Middle part fine breeze at 4 A M raised the
Blanca of Massapee 4 points on the weather
Bow at 7 A M wore ship to the S W the Land
dist 10 or twelve miles Latter part squally
Long by Chron 80° 33' W Lat by Obs 34° 03' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 19th
Fore part strong breeze from N W heading
to the S W toward employed making
rope & Middle & Latter parts calm with
rain squally one Brig in sight

Remarks Wanda Mar 20th
Fore part calm employed repairing the Spunk
furnished & sent it the Blanca in sight to the
N Wward dist 40 miles Middle part calm
Latter part took a breeze from the Southward
stirring & by N employed repairing the Ship's
Long by Chron 80° 00' W Lat by Obs 34° 08' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 21st
Fore part strong breeze from S W stirring
& by N employed sail mending & Middle
part the wind hauling to the S W Latter part
the same Long by Chron 77° 40' W Lat by Obs 35° 35' S

Remarks Wanda Mar 22nd
Fore part strong gales from the S E heading
to the E under double reefed Topgallant Middle
part moderate Latter part a fair breeze
from E. N E to E by E got into green water
broke out for Bread Meat & water
Long by Chron 75° 54' W Lat by Obs 35° 44' S
