Fore part moderate furnished painting took
off a Bag of Coffee 3 men ran away from the
Starboard watch names were Bill John Johnson
& Riley the Starboard watch went ashore on
Liberty for 24 hours, employed breaking out
for & setting up rope shocks, Micael & Lutter
partly moderate

Remarks *Thursday April 3rd*

Fore part fine the Runaways still about
the Starboard watch came off & the S. Watch went
ashore on Liberty the watch on board employed
taking water from the water boat took 2 water
had these men come off we shipped here
& discharged 3 men from the boat & one Boatman
whose time was up the Runaways still about

Remarks *Friday April 4th*

Fore part fine the S. Watch came off with
the exception of the two Moshing Cyprians
got started & they further stopped to take
care of mine took a Tanned load of Wood
on board the Starboard watch went ashore on
Liberty the watch on board employed storing
away wood &c in the afternoon took on board
a lot of Peas & Beans & two Cheats of Copper
the Runaways still about

Remarks *Saturday April 5th*

Fore part moderate Micael & Lutter partly the
wind from the Northward employed cleaning
up decks &c got all ready for Sea caught Bill
Jones & put him in the Gallaboy

Remarks *Sunday April 6th 1862*

Fore part foggy the wind from the Northward
employed breaking out Oil & Coopering at
to send home by the Gaanette put on board
one raft all hands on board except the Runaways

Remarks *Monday April 7th*

Fore part fine weather employed breaking out &
Coopering Oil had a Cooper from the Gaanette
Capt. Henslow Micael & Lutter partly fine weather

Remarks *Tuesday April 8th*

Fore part fine put a raft of Oil on board the
Gaanette a raft of Oil

Remarks *Wednesday April 9th*

Fore part fine furnished discharging Oil &
commenced stowing off discharged in all to the
Gaanette 6437 Gallons of Oil

Remarks *Thursday April 10th*

employed stowing off had the Water Boat long
sick & filled the remainder of our water
Casks 34 long in all

Remarks *Friday April 11th*

Fore part fine took on board some Potatoes
& onions furnished stowing off

Saturday April 12th

Fore part fine caught the two other runaways
Riley & Willson we are now all ready for sea
had 3 Kanakas came on board we shipped here

Remarks *Sunday April 13th*

Fore part rainy wind from the S. cleared off
in the afternoon Micael & Lutter partly
foggy
