

Back Nahlaa Bay of Dartmouth Capt Howland  
Remarks Thrusa May 1<sup>st</sup> 1862

Fore part a gale from E & E steering & X & X at dark heaved to the wind took in the fore & aft & close reefed the main heading E & X & latter part strong Gale Long by Chron 78° 04' Lat by Obs 27° 09' S

Remarks Thrusa May 2<sup>nd</sup>

Fore part strong Gale from E & E from ship to the E & W. Saw some Fin Backs Middle part moderate latter part light breeze heading to the Eastward with cloudy weather No Obs

Remarks Saturday May 3<sup>rd</sup>

Fore part fine breeze from E & E cloudy heading to the Eastward at dark shortened sail the crew making a short Cask out of a pipe & broke out for water Middle & latter parts squally with rain steering to the Westward No Obs

Remarks Sunday May 4<sup>th</sup>

Fore part fresh breeze from E & E, steering E & E one sail in sight at dark took in sail & heaved to the wind heading E & S Middle part moderate latter part squally & calm Lat by Obs 27° 06' S

Remarks Monday May 5<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light air from the steering & X & the Island of St Felix in sight ahead Middle part steering N & N & W latter part moderate at 10 A M two boats went in fishing at St Felix

Remarks Thrusa May 6<sup>th</sup>

Fore part light breeze from E & E at sundown the boats got aboard from fishing caught about two Blk Middle part heading to the Eastward at 7 A M bore shift to the S & W Pease on squally double reefed the fore & aft Long by Chron 78° 30' W Lat by Obs 26° 00' S

Cruising about the Island of St Felix  
Remarks Thrusa May 7<sup>th</sup> 1862

Fore part a gale from E & E heading to the E & W saw nothing broke out a Bl of Blk Middle & latter parts the same St Felix in sight on the lee quarter the weather cloudy No Obs

Remarks Thrusa May 8<sup>th</sup>

Fore part strong gale from E & E heading to the E & W found a Cask of Beef about 4 1/2 or 5 Blk Middle part moderate latter part fine weather employed breaking out for water &c Lat by Obs 28° 14' S

Remarks Thrusa May 9<sup>th</sup>

Fore part moderate breeze from E & E tacked ship to the E & E employed picking over Plating Coiled a saw plane to the E Middle & latter parts fine weather nearly calm employed overhauling the cutting gear &c Long by Chron 79° 09' W Lat by Obs 27° 09' S

Remarks Saturday May 10<sup>th</sup>

Fore part nearly calm employed repairing the cutting gear &c the wind from the Westward steering E painted the Boat Middle part moderate at 6 P M raised Spinn W hales on the Sea Buin at 7 1/2 P M toward the Lagoon struck turned him up the other Boats chased off did not get fast broke the whale long side at 12 got dinner & got ready for cutting Long 78° 40' W Lat 28° S

Remarks Sunday May 11<sup>th</sup>

Fore part fresh breeze from W heading E & E at 2 P M hooked on & commenced cutting got his head off had bad luck tore out three times at dark slackened down & let him rest Middle part moderate latter part light breeze with a heavy swell calmed all hands at 5 A M hooked on finished cutting at 12 Lat by Obs 28° 12' S
