Remarks Anna May 12th 1862
Fore part moderate breeze from the N heading
to the S W sailed the case started the work
to cleared up deck Middle & latter parts moderate
employed Boiling Tong 8th Lat by Obs 25th 14 S

Remarks Anna May 13th
Fore part the wind hauled round to the S E
had some squalling rain employed Boiling
at dusk took in sail & were ship to the S E
Middle & latter parts continue moderate
finished Boiling all but the stove at 7 PM
Lat by Obs

Remarks Anna May 14th
Fore part light breeze from the Eastward heading
S the whale turned up rising 11th at dusk took
in sail Middle part had some rain squally
latter part moderate called all hands at daylight
got up a tackle over the main hatch & commenced
heaving out oil to cooper found some of it had leaked
a little
Tong by Chron 8th 14th Lat by Obs 27th 27 S

Remarks Anna May 15th
Fore part squally from the S E heading to the
Eastward employed heaving out & cooping oil
all hands employed Middle & latter parts
moderate employed stowing down &c
Lat by Obs 27th 107 S

Remarks Anna May 16th
Fore part continuing moderate wind from the
S E heading to the S E employed stowing
down finished at dusk & stowed off the
whale stowed down Middle & latter parts
moderate called all hands at daylight employed
heaving out the Fore Peak for Shooks &c
Lat by Obs 27th 107 S

Cruising about St. Felix
Remarks Anna May 17th 1862
Fore part light air from the Northward heading
to the Eastward employed stowing off the
Fore Peak started a pile of pork & beef at dusk
raining Middle & latter parts light wind &
calm
Lat by Obs 28th 8 S

Remarks Anna May 18th
Fore part light air & calm one sail in sight
employed picking over Platoon &c at dusk light
breeze from S W heading S E Middle part
the same latter part took a breeze from S W
heading to the S E, with foggy squally two sails
in sight

Remarks Anna May 19th
Fore part fresh breeze from S W heading to the
Northward Middle & latter parts squally with
rain kept her off S E at 7 PM employed setting
up Shooks &c Tong by Chron 6th 4th Lat by Obs 26th 36 S

Remarks Anna May 20th
Fore part strong breeze from N W steering S E by E
with squally rain weather saw plenty of Finbacks
Middle part the wind hauling S W latter
part the same saw plenty of Finbacks
Tong by Chron 4th 16th Lat by Obs 25th 11 S

Remarks Anna May 21st
Fore part strong breeze from the Southward steering
N E by E employed heaving out for Shooks &c the Cooper
setting up Shooks Middle & latter parts the
same took out for vinegar &c
Lat by Obs 24th 41 S
